#### Our Mission

Circle Match connects driven students from low-income communities to the college-going process by providing near-peer college advising. Rather than charging students, our self-sustaining approach empowers them to return to Circle Match and pay it forward within their own communities.

#### What We Provide

Students receive expert guidance from advisors who are from the same geographic area, and oftentimes, from the same high school community, so that they have a better social and cultural understanding of where the students are from. Starting from January of their Junior year, Circle Match provides:

- Advisor-led peer cohorts
- Individualized essay writing instruction
- SAT/ACT preparation
- Interview preparation
- Personalized college application strategy
- Long-term Circle Match alumni support
- Leadership development
- Community building events
- College precision support

Circle Match also hosts public events where all students and friends are invited to learn about various college application topics and the post-secondary education scape.

## Our Program

#### AN OVERVIEW OF THE CIRCLE MATCH CURRICULUM

In January, students in their junior year from our partner high schools find out whether they have been admitted to the Circle Match program. Students are placed within a cohort of around five students and assigned advisors who receive on-going training to address the students' academic and social-emotional college needs throughout the application process. Within program, students:

- 1. Apply for various programs that serve as formative assessments
- 2.Refine their writing abilities through 1-on-1 essay feedback
- 3.Curate a personalized college application list
- 4.Learn about college application theory
- 5. Receive interview preparation

Within the curriculum, students apply to the College Prep Scholars program and QuestBridge, which help students understand the rigor of submitting a highly competitive application.

Through each application iteration, advisors provide students with 1-on-1 essay feedback, identifying ways for students to

reflect upon and convey their own stories. With constant practice and constructive feedback, students are able to sharpen their prose while learning ways to hone their writing voice to convincingly and maturely portray themselves. Prior applying to colleges, students curate a college list based on their many rounds of research advisor feedback. Simultaneously, students learn about college application theory and implement strategies, such as applying to schools Early Decision (ED). Lastly, also receive interview students preparation and individualized resume feedback.

Upon completion of the program, students join our robust support network where they pay it forward and begin working as an advisor to younger students or staff fellow.

#### Sept College Speaker and Networking Panel







The past year has been a transformative year for Circle Match, marked by growth, milestones, and deepened impact. We expanded our reach to serve more schools and students than ever before, celebrated recognition from local and state leaders, and started to establish partnerships with corporations and universities to empower our advisors and students. As we look to the future, we are excited to continue building pathways to college and beyond, creating opportunities for the next generation of changemakers. ## What Sets Us Apart

Unlike other non-profit college advising programs, Circle Match focuses on community, grassroot efforts to combat the injustices currently present in our academic environment. Instead of paying for our services, we provide students with a platform to advise future generations of students from their own communities. This grassroots model and approach ensures sustainable growth for our program.

After completing the program, our students pay it forward by joining the team to advise students who have walked in their own shoes. As a result, each advisor who works with students understands the context in which they are coming from: whether it be from attending the same high school or being from a town with very similar demographics and culture. This unique perspective ensures that our students know what a compelling college application can look like from their specific high school.

We also prioritize forming a close-knit community among our students and advisors. This creates a support network that aids the student especially when applying to selective colleges and universities which may feel like uncharted territory. It is through this, that our students ultimately attain the college experience of their dreams and choose to come back to continue paying Circle Match's mission of ending educational inequity.

#### **About our Cohorts**

Data from 2023–2024 based on 44 collected anonymous responses from students currently in our junior year program and students who have completed our senior year program:

80% of our students are or will be first-generation college students

 $9\,5\,\%$  of our students are served or were on free/reduced priced lunch in high school

**87%** of our Belong to Underrepresented Minority Groups

The average total household income of our students is \$44,000 per year

## **Program Highlights**

Since 2019, Circle Match has served **80 students** across Memorial High School, North Bergen High School, Union City High School, Garfield High School, and Franklin Delano Roosevelt HS in Brooklyn.

#### FOR THE CIRCLE MATCH CLASS OF 2024:

93% were admitted to highly competitive college

100% enrolled in a 4-year college/university

100% felt that Circle Match increased their chances of admission to a 4-year college



#### AFTER CIRCLE MATCH:

71% have paid it forward within circle match (e.g. offering college advising services)

100% strongly agreed upon the importance of going back to help their home community
